New city tax was implemented in Rome

Dear Sir or Madam,

Please, pay your kind attention to the fact that the city of Rome (Italy) is introducing a new city tax. This tax will be levied on all visitors depending on the type of accommodation chosen, with the exception of hostels.

This measure was approved by the Rome City Council in an effort to generate additional revenue for the improvement of services and infrastructure offered to the tourist. The fees are as follows:

- € 3.00 PER PERSON PER NIGHT for stays in 5 Star and 4 Star hotels (charged up to 10 nights)
- € 2.00 PER PERSON PER NIGHT for stays in 3 Star, 2 Star, 1 Star hotels (charged up to 10 nights)

Children under two years of age are exempt from paying this tax.

We hope this information will make business travel management process and the trip itself easier.
